Whether the rental property is new or old, there is always a possibility mold could be present. Be alert, pay attention, and ask questions when walking through a potential appartment.

KEEP YOUR EYES PEELED APARTMENT/CONDO WIDE...

- Areas with musty or mildew-like smells
- Areas of water damage
- Areas of discoloration on the walls, floor, and ceiling
- Rooms that may have been or are home to indoor plants

Areas of high moisture or humidity

- Staining, discoloration, or leaks around windows
- Peeling wallpaper
- **Buckling wood floors**
- Poor caulking around sinks, tubs, toilets, and showers
- Old or worn roof
- Poor landscape drainage
